Call for Posters

PRO-VE 2026 is a forum for sharing and discussing current developments and experiences regarding the role and dynamics of collaborative networks in the age of synergic intelligence between human and AI.

We invite researchers and practitioners from various disciplines, including Engineering, Managerial and Socio-Human sciences, to showcase their research through a dedicated **Poster Session**.

This category is specially addressing early stages of research, e.g. early stages of a PhD work, providing an opportunity to collect feedback on the research question and approach. A special discussion session is planned to discuss the posters.

Please note that Posters can be proposed on any topic related to Collaborative Networks, without any restriction. Emerging topics on collaborative networks are also welcome.
